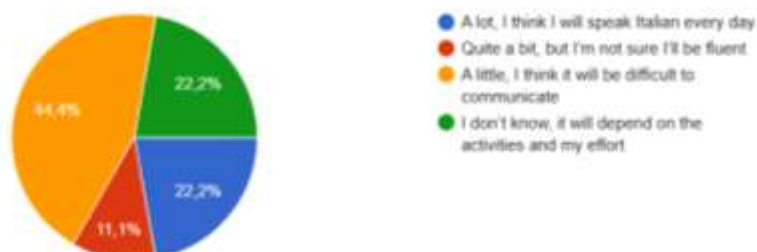

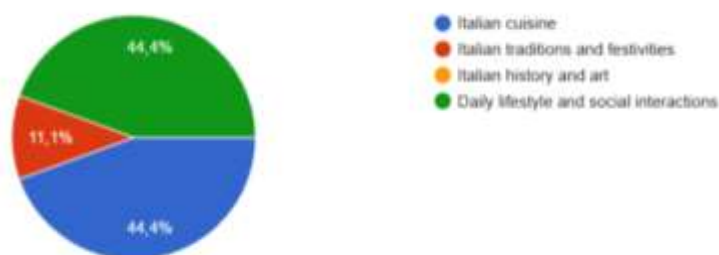

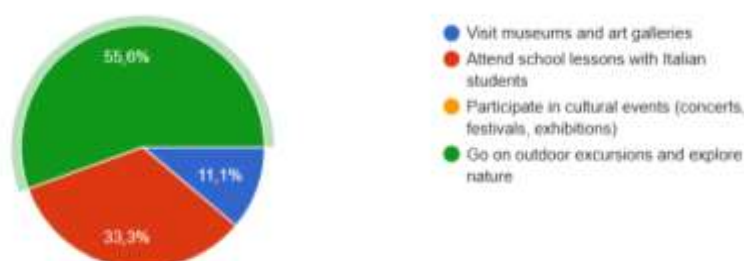

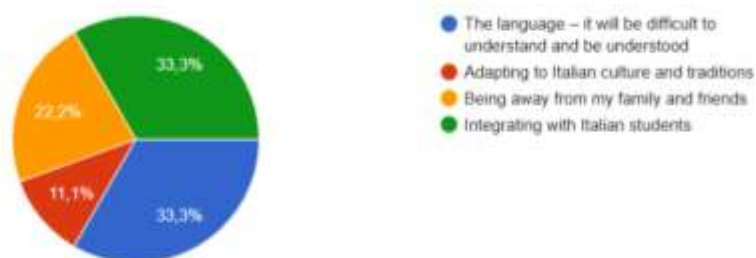

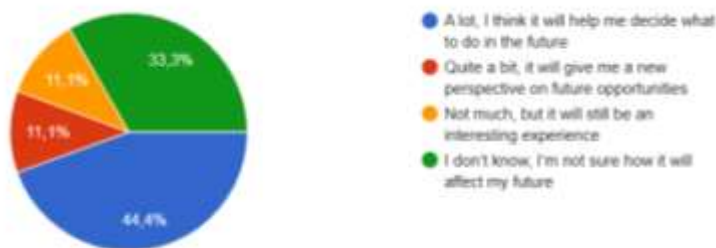

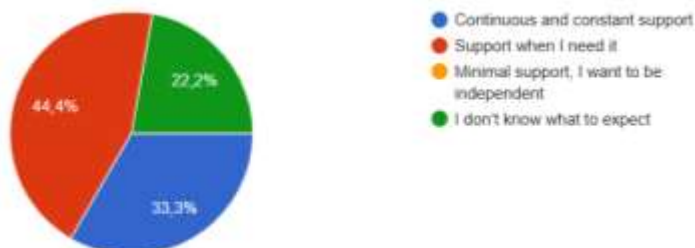

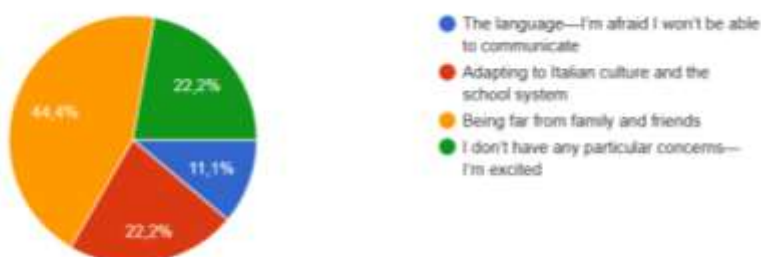

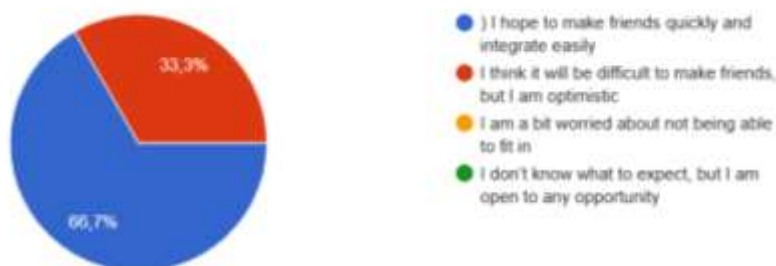

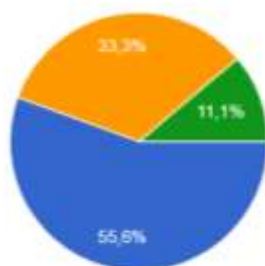

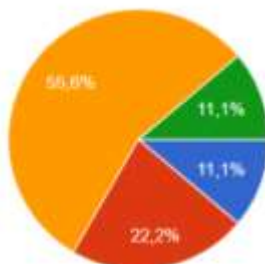


14. Which of these Italian expressions would you like to learn?
